

Lessons Learned:

- 1. Know where you are best at working
- 2. You cannot do anything at any cost
- 3. Be clear about your expectations with investor/lenders/regulators










Lessons Learned:

- 1. # of properties matters more than the # of units
- 2. Layered financing = delays
- 3. Manage integration of company cultures
- It is in your interest to keep the other side in business long enough to complete the transaction
- 5. Have a clear deadline to exit executives



Vacaville Community Housing

6 properties; 437 units 1 cities; 1 counties

Lessons Learned:

- 1. Build local relationships
- 2. Board of Directors legacy is important
- 3. Devil is in the details
- Need to staff up / have a succession plan to be successful.


